If more than one fire code permit is required, the minimum hourly rate applies and then services will be charged at the hourly rate to the nearest 1/2 hour bases on actual time spent at the facility.

A time keeping form will be kept to track time spent on your project. You will be charged for the actual time spent to the nearest 1/2 hour, at a rate of \$190.00 per hour, with a minimum as noted above. The Fire Department will also charge direct and indirect costs for actual expenses incurred for consultant and/or contractual services plus overhead which may be necessary to review your project. The fee will be collected at the completion of your project, and an invoice will be mailed to you. The fees are due and payable upon the receipt of the invoice. Your project permit will not receive final Fire Department approval until all fees are paid. In addition to not issuing final approval, the Fire Department will pursue all other legal remedies for unpaid accounts. On projects that accumulate more than 3 hours in services, you will be invoiced during each month that the balance exceeds 3 hours.

I have read the above statement regarding fees for this project, and I understand how the fees will be calculated, agree to pay such fees, and understand that they are due prior to final acceptance of my project. Further, under penalty of perjury, I declare that I am duly authorized to encumber expenses on behalf of the firm listed above.
